El Yunque National Forest in Puerto Rico's northern region is the only tropical rainforest in the U.S. National Forest System. It is known for its biodiversity, lush canopies, waterfalls, and unique species like the coquí frog. Conservation efforts focus on protecting habitats, restoring trails, and supporting the climate after weather events, such as hurricanes or tropical storms.
